



	Objectives
Personal, Social & Emotional	Encourage your child to play co-operatively with their siblings or other family members, taking their turn in games and sharing their toys. Discuss how they can have 'kind hands' that share and also help to tidy away their toys when they have finished playing with them.
Physical Development	Noah's Ark cutting activity – resource pack available from Pre-school, please contact the school office if you require these resources.
Communication & Language	Encourage your child to follow simple, verbal instructions whilst cutting out the animals for their Ark.
Literacy	Listen to the story about Noah's Ark by copying and pasting the following link into You Tube. <a href="https://youtu.be/gGAcaFfWmiQ">https://youtu.be/gGAcaFfWmiQ</a>
Maths	If you have small word animals can your child put them into pairs? Can they count how many animals might have gone onto the Ark?
Understanding The World	Talk about how we can look after God's world and the animals that went onto the Ark.
Expressive Arts & Design	If you have an old cardboard box create your own ark with your child. Encourage them to retell the story using their ark and add some small world animals. Look at the rainbow that was at the end of the story, can they paint their own rainbow?
Phonics	Jolly phonics – on You Tube. Listen to the song about this week's sounds and encourage your child to join in and copy the actions. This week's sounds are as follows: v, w, x, z, k.
Kinetic Letters	Make some playdough with your child by mixing flour and water together. Encourage them to use their hands to roll and flatten the dough and create some of the animals that went onto the Ark.
